

CCS ACTIVEX MANUAL INSTALLATION

The control web page of CCS IP codecs is a dynamic web page based on an ActiveX control which must be downloaded and installed on the computer running IExplorer first time one of our codecs is accessed via the web page.

In some computers and due to security reasons, the installation and downloading of ActiveX controls might be banned. In order to allow the user to use and access the web page of our units under these circumstances, we provide our customers with an Active manual installer that allows the user to install the corresponding ActiveX control manually, avoiding problems with the security settings of IExplorer.

I.1 Installation

This software can be obtained from the CCS web download section. First download the zip file containing all necessary files for the installation, then decompress all the contents of the zip file on a folder of your choice.

Once all files have been installed on the computer, look for the file named 'SuprimaFamily_ManualInstall.inf'. Right click on it and select the option 'install'.

A new window will pop up informing the user about the installation progress. Once the installation is done and everything was ok, this window will close.

I.2 ActiveX usage

This software is used by Internet Explorer and is transparent to the user. Once the web control page of one of our units is accessed, if the ActiveX control for that firmware version is not installed on that computer and, if Internet Explorer was configured to allow the user to download and install ActiveX controls, the ActiveX for that version will be installed on the computer. Once the ActiveX is downloaded (from the codec) and installed, the web page will open up, and Internet Explorer will make use of it transparently to the user.

In case the ActiveX control was already installed manually as per the procedure hereby described, Internet Explorer will make use of the ActiveX control as soon as the web page is accessed, with no further intervention from the user.
